How to Enroll in Credit / Non-credit ESL classes

1. Take a Placement Test & Get Academic Counseling:

Come to the ESL Center (Language Center) at the Northeast Campus to take the free ESL Placement Exam. We are open for testing Monday through Thursday (arrive between 9 am - 5 pm) and Friday (by appointment, arrive between 9 am - 3 pm). Extended testing hours will be available in the evening Monday through Thursday during August. The address is 3727 E Apache, Tulsa OK 74115. Please come to the Student Union building on the east side of the campus. Parking lots 8 and 9 are the closest. The ESL Center (Language Center) is in room SU109.

After you submit your exam, an ESL staff member will talk with your about your results and courses for your level. The ESL staff member will also answer your questions and help you with your enrollment.

2. Submit an Application:

Credit students only: Submit an application online at www.tulsacc.edu, click on "Apply". If you are a US permanent resident, you should upload a color scan of your permanent resident card with your application. If you need help, please come to the ESL Center or call (918) 595-8411 for assistance. Additional documents may be required. You will receive your TCC student ID number by email in 5 to 7 days. Please contact the ESL counselor at (918) 595-8411 or <u>salli.wandke@tulsacc.edu</u> with any questions or for more information.

Non-credit learners only: An ESL staff member will submit your application for you when you enroll. You will receive your TCC student ID number by email 5 to 7 days after you enroll. If you do not receive it, please let an ESL staff member know.

3. Enroll in Classes:

Credit students: An ESL staff member will assist you with your enrollment. Please come to the ESL Center to enroll.

Non-credit learners: An ESL staff member will assist you with your enrollment. Please come to the ESL Center to enroll. Non-credit learners will receive an email and printed copy with the class or classes they are registered in.

All Students: If you have questions you can call or email Blanca, Salli, or Daniel. However, during enrollment we are very busy and may be unable to answer calls quickly. We recommend that you come in person.

Late enrollments after August 23rd are strongly discouraged and are only on a space available basis.

4. Pay Your Fees:

Credit students only: Pay for your classes online using MYTCC or at the Bursar's office, (www.tulsacc.edu and click on "MYTCC".) Your username is your student ID number including the "T". Select "first time" and follow the prompts to set your password. Credit students may also choose to enroll in the TCC payment plan on their MYTCC. For more information, please contact the Bursar's Office or ESL counselor.

Non-credit learners only: Please pay for your classes at the time of enrollment. We accept Visa, MasterCard (debit or credit), or Discover cards, checks, or cash.

How to Enroll in Credit / Non-credit ESL classes (continued)

6. Get an ID Card:

ID cards are made in the Student Life Office in room SU236 on the second floor of the Student Union Monday through Thursday 9am to 6 pm (closed on Friday).

- Credit students only: Please bring your student ID number and a photo ID.
- **Non-credit learners only:** The cost is included in your course fee. Please bring a photo ID and your receipt showing your ID number. If you have questions, please contact the ESL Department.

Please <u>DO NOT</u> throw your ID card away at the end of the semester. The cost to replace it is \$20. Your ID card will be revalidated each semester when you pay your tuition and fees.

7. Refund Policy for Course Withdrawal (Dropped Class):

100% Refunds for course withdrawals (dropped classes) from credit or non-credit ESL courses are only given during the first week of the semester. After the first week, there is no refund. Please contact an the ESL Department for assistance.

English Proficiency Requirements For Classes Other Than ESL

Policy

All applicants who indicate English as a second language shall be required to provide evidence of proficiency in the English language prior to enrollment in college-level courses.

Procedure

One of the following standards is used to determine English Language Proficiency for all first time applicants prior to enrolling in college-level credit courses:

1. **Standardized Testing:** Students must meet one of the following minimum scores for admission to TCC without taking ESL:

Internet-Based TOEFL [®] (iBT)	61
Paper-Based TOEFL [®]	500
IELTS	5.5
PTE Academic	44
iTEP Academic	3.5

Intensive English Program (IEP): This program is a matriculation program which allows students to enter TCC college classes by proving their readiness through testing *and* class work. Students must achieve a qualifying score on one of the following tests:

Internet-Based TOEFL [®] (iBT)	48-60	
Paper-Based TOEFL [®]	460-499	
IELTS	5.0-5.4	
PTE Academic	36-43	
iTEP Academic	3.0-3.4	

After achieving an acceptable score, students must successfully complete a minimum of 12 weeks of study at an IEP approved by the Oklahoma State Regents immediately prior to TCC admission. At least two-thirds of the 12 weeks must be instruction at an advanced level.

- 3. High School Performance: Students must successfully complete the high school core requirements in an English-speaking high school or graduate from an English-speaking high school and demonstrate competency through the *Policy on Remediation and Removal of High School Curricular Deficiencies*. Students must take the college placement test in the Testing Center. The results will be used to demonstrate proficiency in English and math to determine the appropriate remediation.
- 4. **Previous College Performance:** Students must provide an official transcript showing a minimum of 24 college-level credit hours with passing grades from an accredited American college or university.

Placement Testing

ESL Placement Testing:

Any student who wishes to enroll in ESL classes for the first time must take the ESL Placement Exam. The ESL Placement Exam measures reading, writing, listening, speaking and grammar and is used to ensure that the student is enrolled in ESL classes at the appropriate level. The following are some common questions about the ESL Placement test:

How much does it cost?	There is no charge for the ESL Placement Exam.	
How much time does it take?	The ESL Placement Exam takes approximately 1 hours.	
How can I register for the exam?	There is no advanced registration needed.

Tuition Information

Tuition:

The following chart shows the approximate tuition rate for non-resident and resident credit students. Non-credit rates are also listed. Please note that other fees may apply. Most courses require a textbook, which is not included in tuition.

Credit ESL Classes:

Tuition must be paid in full at the time of enrollment and can be paid by cash, check, or credit/debit card or the student must enroll in the payment plan. For more information or to enroll in the payment plan, please go to MYTCC on the TCC website or visit the Bursar's Office. If you need help setting up the payment plan, please visit the Bursar's Office or ask an ESL staff member.

Non-Credit ESL Classes:

Tuition must be paid in full at the time of enrollment by cash, check or Visa, MasterCard (credit/debit), and Discover. Please note that textbooks are not included in the tuition. There is no payment plan available.

All students:

Late enrollments after August 23rd are strongly discouraged and only on a space available basis.

Tuition Information

Additional fees:

Credit students only: There is a \$5.00 per semester ID fee and a one-time \$20 admission fee.

Non-credit learners only: The ID fee is included in your course fee.

Books:

Books are approximately \$40 -\$70 per course. Prices will vary for each course.

Refunds:

For 12 week classes, 100% refund during the first week of the class only. <u>No refund after</u> the first week.

Dropping Classes:

Credit students only: If a credit student does not plan to attend a course, it is the student's responsibility to officially drop his or her class(es) by notifying the Registrar's Office before the end of the refund period. Please contact the ESL Counselor if you need assistance.

Non-credit learners only: Non-credit learners must contact the ESL Specialist, ESL Counselor, or ESL Director before the end of the refund period.


Map and Directions
